

## CH13: $\alpha$ -Material

### Quote

τοῖσι δὲ μὴ βουλομένοισι αὐτῶν ἐνοικέειν, αὐτόσε δὲ ναυτιλλομένοισι ἔδωκε χώρους ἐνιδρύσασθαι βωμοὺς καὶ τεμένεα θεοῖσι.

### Aspect

- **aoristic:** undefined, i.e., simple action
- **imperfective:** open-ended, not completed, progressive—**PROCESS-EFFORT** oriented as opposed to just doing it, and so emphasizing one of the following (here using English past time):

ἐκάθευδε (**imperfect tense, imperfective aspect**). “She was sleeping,” that is. . .

1. Continuation: “She was sleeping the whole time!”
2. Repetition: “She’d frequently be dozing off.”
3. Habit: “She used to doze-off” / “She’d typically doze off.”
4. Inception: “She began to doze off” / “She was beginning to doze off.”
5. Attempt: “She tried to doze off” / “She was trying to doze off.”

### Greek Imperfect Tense

- Greek imperfect tense represents: PAST TIME + IMPERFECTIVE ASPECT
- Regular (thematic) imperfect endings = regular 2nd aorist endings (*Athenaze* pp. 213 ff.):
  - imperfect — formed how (“free” λύω λύσω ἔλυσα)?
    1. take PRESENT STEM λύ-
    2. add AUGMENT ἔ-
    3. add ENDINGS (see table above) ἔ-λυ-ov
- Endings of the regular (thematic) imperfect:
