Information for students just adding the class

- 1) Before class on Monday, January 27th, read “Class notes” Section II) and Section III) parts A)-C). What are these “Class notes”? See below.
- 2) Do problem set 1 as instructed below and bring it to class on Monday.
- 3) No phones or laptops in class. Take notes in a notebook. If you prefer to take notes on an iPad sort of thing, OK, but I will be watching you suspiciously.
